



## LAMP (Linux – Apache – MySQL – PHP)

**Description:**

This course is aimed at people who run their own webserver or work in a webhosting environment. We will teach you the basics of Linux so you can get around on a machine, check what services are running and start or stop them. We will show you how Apache is installed and how a basic configuration is done. During a quick overview we will explain different options available in the apache config file. During the MySQL and PHP sessions you will learn how to install the software and set up the links between Apache, MySQL and PHP. Of course, we will teach you some basic commands you can use with MySQL and PHP.
