- Main differences between 1.3.x and 2.x versions
- Enabling apache modules
- Starting, restarting and stopping the HTTP service
- Understanding and analyzing traffic logs
- Setting up IP based virtual hosting
- Setting up name-based virtual hosting
- Password - protected webpages
- Basic SSL (for HTTPS) setup and configuration
- CGI configuration for dynamic webpages (e.g. Server side scripting)
- Standard web server administration troubleshooting
- MIME

Who should attend:

Linux users; whether a developer, system administrator, support team member or network administrator. This course is designed to provide a solid stepping stone to Apache.

Prerequisites:

Delegates should have a working knowledge of a Unix environment (LINUX, Solaris, HP-UX, AIX, ...). This can be gained from attending our Linux Fundamentals course. Practical knowledge of TCP/IP concepts. This course has not been designed with IT novices in mind.
