



RUNNING SENDMAIL BASIC

Length: 1 day

Description: This training will teach you the basics of the world's most used MTA, Sendmail. With the endless amount of options and features Sendmail is sometimes a bit overwhelming for the beginning user. This training will put you on the right track and shows you how to install and configure a basic, working sendmail. If you want to get deeper into Sendmail, you can continue after this training with the Advanced Training.
